The application to the MLT Program is currently not available. The deadline to submit an application was December 31, 2016. A new application will be available in September, 2017, and will be available until December 31, 2017.



<u>To Prospective Medical Laboratory Technician Students:</u>

If you plan to apply next year, you can start the process by:

- Completing an Edison State Community College application form
- Submitting a final transcript after graduation from high school.
- Having your official transcripts from all colleges and universities previously attended sent to Registration and Records for evaluation.
- Submitting ACT (American College Test) or SAT (Scholastic Aptitude Test) results, if taken within 5 years of application date, **OR**
- Taking the Accuplacer assessment for reading, writing and mathematics. Contact the <u>Student Services Office</u> at 778-8600 to schedule the Accuplacer.
- Completing the prerequisite coursework: one year of high school chemistry within the last five (5) years **OR** CHM 110S; satisfactory math assessment score and three (3) years of college prep math, or a grade of "B" or better in MTH 097D, intermediate Algebra II; satisfactory assessment scores in reading and writing to be ready to take ENG 121S, or successfully complete ENG 091D and ENG 093D. Also, complete the first semester courses listed for the MLT degree as listed on the Edison website at:
