The Commission on Accreditation in Physical Therapy Education (CAPTE) requires public disclosure of student outcomes specific to graduation rate, licensure exam pass rate, and employment rate. The outcomes for students enrolled in the PTA program at Edison State Community College are as follows:

<sup>1</sup>Graduation Rate as defined by the Commission on Accreditation in Physical Therapy Education (CAPTE) is the percent of students who complete the technical program within 150% of the normally expected time. The percentage of students who are matriculated in the first technical course in the program after the add/drop period and who complete the program.

<sup>2</sup>Licensure Pass Rate as defined by the Commission on Accreditation in Physical Therapy Education (CAPTE) is the percent of students that passed the licensure exam. The data reflects the Ultimate Pass rate as reported by the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy.

<sup>3</sup>Employment Rate as defined by the Commission on Accreditation in Physical Therapy Education (CAPTE) is the percent of graduates who sought employment that were employed within 6 months of passing the licensure exam.
