Prerequisite: Minimum grade of "C" in LEG 110S, LEG 130S, LEG 211S, LEG 231S, LEG 240S, and BUS 223S; a 2.5 minimum GPA in all LEG courses; and department permission. Co-requisite: LEG 290R.
