COURSE DESCRIPTION

An internship of 115 clock hours. Practical phlebotomy experience is obtained in an affiliated clinical site. Internship is observed and unpaid. Prerequisite: ALH 101S, MED 150S, OSA 111S, OSA 151S, and departmental permission. Co-requisite: PLB 291R.
