SYLLABUS PART I

EDISON STATE COMMUNITY COLLEGE MED 291L MEDICAL ASSISTING INTERNSHIP 2 CREDIT HOURS

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course provides the student with first-hand experience in the medical setting. Students will utilize skills learned in previous coursework and apply those skills in a physician's office or other ambulatory setting. The course consists of 160 hours of unpaid time at the intern site for observation and practice of administrative and clinical techniques. Prerequisite: ALH 151S, MED 230S, MED 233S, MED 120S, MED 150S, MED 220S with grades of C or better. Co-requisite: MED 291R. Completion of pre-internship competency checklist. Departmental permission. Lab fee.
