Agreement for the Articulation Agriculture Pathways Programs

Edison State Community College and Jay School Corporation

Effective January 2017

Purposes:

- > To recognize the achievement of students and faculty at Jay County High School (JCHS)
- > To offer college credit to all affiliated students and to award credit for those who merit it
- > To create a seamless pathway to college that avoids unnecessary duplication of content
- > To hold both high school and college students to the same rigorous standards for credit

This agreement applies to students who have:

- 1. Completed successfully the applicable Agriculture career field pathway course(s),
- 2. Been accepted for admission and enrolled in the AAS Agriculture program at Edison State CC within two years of graduation.

The parties agree that:

- 1. College credit will be awarded for the appended college courses (Application for College Credit) for achievement of the IDOE end-of-course assessment performance standard.
- 2. The instructor will submit each student's Application for College Credit to Edison State Community College by the stated deadline.
- 3. All students will submit an application to Edison State Community College.
- 4. Students must matriculate at ESCC within two (2) years of graduation from high school for the credit to be transcripted.
- 5. This agreement will be valid for a period of three years from the effective date with an annual review by the Jay County instructor/administrator and ESC program. The parties will meet every three years to update curriculum and assessment procedures and to approve a new agreement.
- 6. Changes to this agreement may be requested at any time by notification from either party.
- 7. Credits will be added to the transcript and counted toward a pathway degree program at Edison State Community College.
