¹Retention Rate is define as those who have completed the program based off of passing the trigger course. The trigger course is MED 120S, which is offered in the Fall and Spring. Some students in the Fall and Spring 2018 cohorts are still in progress for completion.

²Exam Pass Rate will be compiled once the recommendation from the MAERB is made to CAAHEP for the approved accreditation, for the 2018 cohorts.

³Employment Rate is determined from raw data such as graduation surveys, phone calls to the practicum coordinator, and employer surveys. All graduates in the MA program were hired as Medical Assistant or in a related field at the site that they completed their 160-hour internship.

⁴Employer Surveys Participation is based on the total number of surveys sent to current employers that have hired recent graduates of the MA program and have returned the surveys. These are completed 3 to 6 months after the graduate is hired.

⁵ Employer Satisfaction Rate. Employer satisfaction rates are based off of survey questions that cover the employees' skills related to psychomotor, affective, and cognitive ability at an entry-level.

⁶ Graduate Survey Participation is based on the total number of surveys sent to recent graduates of the MA program and have returned the surveys. These are completed 0 to 3 months after the completion of the program.

⁷ Graduate Survey Satisfaction Rate are satisfaction rates are based off of survey questions that cover the skills related to psychomotor, affective, and cognitive ability at an entry-level.
