

# Agreement for the Articulation of Tech Prep Curricula Veterinary Science Program

Edison State Community College and Springfield Clark CTC

Effective August 2019

**Purposes:**

- To recognize the achievement of students and faculty at Springfield Clark CTC (SCCTC)
- To offer college credit to all SCCTC students and to award credit for those who merit it
- To create a seamless pathway to college that avoids unnecessary duplication of content
- To hold both high school and college students to the same rigorous standards for credit

**This agreement applies to students who have:**

1. Successfully completed the two-year Veterinary Science program at SCCTC,
2. Earned an average grade of C or better in all program coursework at SCCTC,
3. Been accepted for admission and enrolled in the AAS - Veterinary Technology program or AAS - Agriculture program at Edison State Community College (ESCC) within two years of graduation from SCCTC.

**The parties agree that:**

1. College credit will be awarded for the appended courses (Application for College Credit) with a passage rate of 80% or higher on the college administered proficiency exam as required by Edison State Community College or college credit will be articulated for the appended college course (Application for College Credit) for achievement of the ODE end-of-course assessment (WebXam) performance standard.
2. The SCCTC teacher will submit each student's Application for College Credit to ESCC by the stated deadline.
3. All SCCTC students will submit an application to ESCC.
4. Students must matriculate at ESCC within two (2) years of graduation from high school to access the transcribed credit.
5. This agreement will be valid for a period of three years from the effective date with an annual review by program high school teachers and college professors. The parties will meet every three years to update curriculum and assessment procedures and to approve a new agreement.
6. Changes to this agreement may be requested at any time by notification from either party.
7. Credits will be added to the transcript and counted toward one of the specified pathway degree programs at ESCC.
