- In order to be admitted fully as a business major at Wright State, students will need to achieve a cumulative GPA of a 2.25.
- Students must earn a C or higher in ENG 121S, ENG 122S, SSV 111S, SSV 113S, and SSV 211S.
- Students must complete the following coursework at Edison State prior to being fully admitted to the Social Work program: BIO 124S, COM 228S, ECO 120S, ENG 121S, ENG 122S, PLS 121S, PSY 121S, SOC 121S, SSV 111S, SSV 113S, and SSV 211S.
- Students must submit a separate application form to the Social Work program by February 1 during their second or sophomore year (while studying at Edison State).
- 134 hours minimum are required for a BA degree at Wright State.

1. ADMISSIONS AND DEADLINES

Join the Wright Path Program

Students interested in applying to the Wright Path must submit a request for membership at wright.edu/wrightpath/edison-state.

High school students must have completed their junior year before applying to the Wright Path, and current Edison State students must have a minimum 2.0 GPA.

Transfer to Wright State University

Students must earn a minimum 2.0 GPA from Edison State Community College in order to transfer to Wright State. To be admitted into the Social Work Program at Wright State, students must earn a minimum 2.25 GPA from Edison State.

Students must apply for admission to Wright State and the Social Work program by February 1 of the sophomore year/year two (while still studying at Edison State).

*Note that students must apply and be admitted to the university before Social Work Program application can be approved.
