Students interested in applying to the Wright Path must submit a request for membership at wright.edu/wrightpath/edison-state.

High school students must have completed their junior year before applying to the Wright Path, and current Edison State students must have a minimum 2.0 GPA.

#### Transfer to Wright State University

Students must earn a minimum 2.0 GPA from Edison State Community College in order to transfer to Wright State. To be admitted into the Intervention Specialist Program at Wright State, students must earn a minimum 2.6 GPA from Edison State Community College.

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\*Note that students must apply and be admitted to the university <u>before</u> Intervention Specialist Program and field applications can be approved.

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In addition to submitting the program application, the following criteria are required for full admission into the Intervention Specialist program:

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- A minimum of 60 semester hours (including in-progress courses)
- Grade of C or higher in each of the following:
  - All Pre-Professional Core courses:
  - MTH 126S at Edison State
  - Any equivalent transfer courses and Wright State courses that are applicable to the Wright State Core Requirements that are related to the students' two respective concentration areas (Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies)
  - All Teacher Education courses: EDU 111S, EDU 213S, and EDU 226S at Edison State
- Passing scores in each of the following areas:
  - One of the following reading scores:
    - ACT reading score of 19 or better
    - o SAT evidence-based reading and writing score of 520 or better
    - ETS praxis core academic skills for educators reading score of 162 or better
  - One of the following writing scores:
