

Agreement for the Articulation of Tech Prep Curricula Engineering

Edison State Community College and Upper Valley Career Center
(Piqua High School Satellite)

Effective August 2020

Purposes:

- To recognize the achievement of students and faculty at Piqua High School (PHS)
- To offer college credit to all PHS students and to award credit for those who merit it
- To create a seamless pathway to college that avoids unnecessary duplication of content
- To hold both high school and college students to the same rigorous standards for credit

This agreement applies to students who have:

1. Successfully completed the three Engineering Design courses at PHS with an average grade of B or better.
2. Been accepted for admission and enrolled in an Engineering program at Edison State Community College within two years of graduation from PHS.

The parties agree that:

1. The PHS instructor will submit each student's Application for College Credit to Edison State Community College by the stated deadline.
2. All students requesting articulated credit will submit an application to Edison State Community College.
3. Students must matriculate at Edison State Community College within two (2) years of graduation from high school for the credit to be transcribed.
4. This agreement will be valid for a period of three years from the effective date with an annual review by program instructor and college professors. The parties will meet every three years to update curriculum and assessment procedures and to approve a new agreement.
5. Changes to this agreement may be requested at any time by notification from either party.
6. Credits will be added to the transcript and counted toward a pathway degree program at Edison State Community College.
