# Agreement for the Articulation of Tech Prep Curricula Medical Tech Prep

Edison State Community College and Greenville High School

### Effective August 2020

#### Purposes:

- > To recognize the achievement of students and faculty at Greenville High School (GHS)
- > To offer college credit to all GHS students and to award credit for those who merit it
- > To create a seamless pathway to college that avoids unnecessary duplication of content
- > To hold both high school and college students to the same rigorous standards for credit
- This agreement applies to students who have:
  - 1. Successfully completed the two-year Medical Tech Prep program at GHS,
  - 2. Earned an average grade of B or better in all program coursework at GHS,
  - 3. Been accepted for admission and enrolled in a medical pathway program at Edison State Community College within two years of graduation from GHS.

#### The parties agree that:

- College credit will be awarded for the appended college courses (Application for College Credit)
  with a passage rate of 70% or higher on the college administered proficiency exam or other
  means of assessment required by Edison State Community College.
- 2. The GHS instructor will submit each student's Application for College Credit to Edison State Community College by the stated deadline.
- 3. All students requesting articulated credit will submit an application to Edison State Community College.
- 4. Students must matriculate at Edison State Community College within two (2) years of graduation from high school for the credit to be transcripted.
- 5. This agreement will be valid for a period of three years from the effective date with an annual review by program instructors and college professors. The parties will meet every three years to update curriculum and assessment procedures and to approve a new agreement.
- 6. Changes to this agreement may be requested at any time by notification from either party.
- 7. Credits will be added to the transcript and counted toward a pathway degree program at Edison State Community College.
