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Description

The Associate in Applied Science of Nursing at Edison State Community College partners well with the RN-BSN completion program at Miami University.

The RN-BSN program requires 124 total credit hours. At least 32 of those hours must be earned at Miami, including the 12 of the final 30 credit hours. The matches below indicate specific courses which may be awarded after successfully completing those courses and transferring to Miami University.

- Ohio Registered Nurse license (or RN in state in which they practice) without restrictions
- Cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher
- ENG 111 College Composition (ENG 121S)
- MBI 161 Elementary Medical Microbiology (BIO 240S & BIO 241S)
- Miami Plan Foundation IIC social science requirement, e.g., PSY 111 Introduction to Psychology (PSY 121S)
- Associate degree nursing
