


**Transfer Agreement
between
University of Northwestern Ohio
and
Edison Community College**

To ensure a smooth transition from associate degrees in accounting, business administration, health-related fields, and specialized studies to baccalaureate degree programs, Edison Community College and the University of Northwestern Ohio agree to cooperate in correlating their programs for the Associate of Applied Business, Associate of Applied Science, Associate of Technical Studies, and the Baccalaureate degrees.

Students who have earned associate degrees in these major fields at Edison Community College can transfer to the University of Northwestern Ohio with junior status. The following transfer principles will apply:

1. The University of Northwestern Ohio is responsible for determining the baccalaureate degree requirements
2. The student transferring into the baccalaureate degree must have earned at least a 2.0 overall grade point average on a 4.0 scale.
3. Edison Community College students must have earned the appropriate major to receive junior standing. For example, the Health Care Administration baccalaureate degree requires an associate degree in a health-related field. Students who have earned associate degrees in unrelated majors must complete the required courses before being admitted to the specific baccalaureate program.
4. Students who need prerequisites for upper-division courses must take those courses as soon as possible.
5. There will be no time restrictions on courses transferred to the University of Northwestern Ohio unless there is a policy on transferred courses for the University of Northwestern Ohio students as well – i.e. Computer courses may need to be revalidated because of rapidly changing technological environment.
6. Edison Community College and the University of Northwestern Ohio will designate specific staff members to facilitate communication.
7. This agreement will become effective for the 2011/2012 academic year and will continue indefinitely unless notification is given in writing (by either institution) 30 days in advance.
8. As new associate degrees are developed at Edison Community College and new baccalaureate degrees are approved for the University of Northwestern Ohio, the same transfer arrangement will apply.




