# Agreement for the Articulation of Tech Prep Curricula Early Childhood Education and Care

Edison State Community College and Upper Valley Career Center

## Effective August 2021

## Purposes:

- > To recognize the achievement of students and faculty at Upper Valley Career Center (UVCC)
- > To offer college credit to all UVCC students and to award credit for those who merit it
- > To create a seamless pathway to college that avoids unnecessary duplication of content
- > To hold both high school and college students to the same rigorous standards for credit

#### This agreement applies to students who have:

- 1. Successfully completed the two-year Early Childhood Education and Care program at UVCC,
- 2. Earned an average grade of C (≥73%) in lab and related coursework at UVCC with successful passage of corresponding Webxam, and
- Been accepted for admission and enrolled in the ECE program at ESCC within two years of graduation from UVCC.

#### The parties agree that:

- 1. Transcripted college credit will be awarded by ESCC for the appended college courses (Application for College Credit) if requirements are met.
- 2. The UVCC teacher will submit each student's Application for College Credit to ESCC by the stated deadline.
- 3. All UVCC students requesting articulated credit will submit an application to ESCC.
- 4. Students must matriculate at ESCC within two (2) years of graduation from high school to access the transcripted credit.
- 5. This agreement will be valid for a period of three years from the effective date with an annual review by program high school teachers and college professors. The parties will meet every three years to update curriculum and assessment procedures and to approve a new agreement.
- 6. Changes to this agreement may be requested at any time by notification from either party.
- 7. Credits will be added to the transcript and counted toward the AAS degree in Early Childhood Education at ESCC.
