Agreement for the Articulation of Tech Prep Curricula Aircraft Owners and Pilots Association (AOPA) Aviation Program

Edison State Community College and Piqua High School

Effective August 2022

Purposes:

- > To recognize the achievement of students and faculty at Piqua High School (PHS)
- > To offer college credit to all PHS students and to award credit for those who merit it
- > To create a seamless pathway to college that avoids unnecessary duplication of content
- > To hold both high school and college students to the same rigorous standards for credit

This agreement applies to students who have:

- 1. Successfully completed the AOPA curriculum at PHS,
- 2. Earned an average grade of B or better in all content coursework at PHS,
- 3. Been accepted for admission and enrolled in the Aviation—Professional Pilot program at Edison State Community College (ESCC) within one year of graduation from PHS.

The parties agree that:

- 1. College credit will be awarded for the appended college courses (Application for College Credit) as verified by the instructor and including required license documentation.
- 2. The PHS teacher will submit each student's Application for College Credit to ESCC by the stated deadline.
- 3. All students requesting articulated credit will submit an application to ESCC.
- 4. This agreement will be valid for a period of three years from the effective date with an annual review by the program high school teacher and college professor. The parties will meet every three years to update curriculum and assessment procedures and to approve a new agreement.
- 5. Changes to this agreement may be requested at any time by notification from either party.
- 6. Credits will be added to the transcript and counted toward a pathway degree program at ESCC.
