- All students with declared Biological Sciences major are automatically admitted as Pre-Biological Sciences students.
- The MLT transfer guide for the BA in Biological Sciences enables students who are certified (ASCP) MLTs to complete a bachelor's degree, as well as an opportunity to become eligible for the MLS (ASCP) certification exam. ## ***Transfer to Wright State University***

Students must earn a minimum 2.0 GPA from Edison State in order to transfer to Wright State.

Wright State processes applications as they are received. To help you make a smooth and timely transition, we recommend you submit your application by the following dates:

Fall Semester:	<b>April 1</b>
Spring Semester:	<b>October 15</b>
Summer Semester:	<b>February 1</b>

Students must apply for undergraduate admission one semester prior to completing their studies at Edison State.

In order to be admitted fully as a biological sciences major at Wright State, students will need to achieve a cumulative GPA of a 2.0.

Students must earn a C or higher in BIO 126S at Edison State.

Students must earn a C or higher in all science and mathematics courses at Edison State and Wright State.
