

Agreement for the Articulation of Tech Prep Curricula

Edison State Community College and Upper Valley Career Center

Effective August 2024

Purposes:

- To recognize the achievement of students and faculty of Upper Valley Career Center (UVCC)
- To offer college credit to all UVCC students and to award credit for those who merit it
- To create a seamless pathway to college that avoids unnecessary duplication of content
- To hold both high school and college students to the same rigorous standards for credit

This agreement applies to students who have:

1. Earned an average grade of 70% or higher on required course assessments.

The parties agree that:

1. College credit will be articulated for CHM 110S—Introduction to Chemistry—4 credit hours with a passage rate of 70% or higher on the required course assessments as evaluated by Edison State Community College faculty.
2. All students requesting articulated credit will submit an application to Edison State Community College.
3. This agreement will be valid for a period of three years from the effective date with an annual review by the UVCC Administration and Edison State Community College. The parties will meet every three years to update curriculum and assessment procedures and to approve a new agreement.
4. Changes to this agreement may be requested at any time by notification from either party.
5. Credits will be added to the transcript and counted toward a degree program at Edison State Community College.
