Agreement for the Articulation of Tech Prep Curricula Early Childhood Education

Edison State Community College and Miami Valley Career Technology Center

Effective August 2024

Purposes:

- > To recognize the achievement of students and faculty at Miami Valley Career Technology Center (MVCTC)
- > To offer college credit to all MVCTC students and to award credit for those who merit it
- > To create a seamless pathway to college that avoids unnecessary duplication of content
- > To hold both high school and college students to the same rigorous standards for credit This agreement applies to students who have:
 - 1. Successfully completed the two-year Early Childhood Education program at MVCTC.
 - 2. Earned an average grade of C or better (≥73%) in lab and related coursework at MVCTC and with successful passage of corresponding Webxam.

The parties agree that:

For Edison State Community College

- 1. College credit will be articulated for the appended college courses (Application for College Credit) if all stated requirements are met.
- 2. The MVCTC instructor will submit each student's Application for College Credit to Edison State Community College by the stated deadline.
- 3. All students requesting articulated credit will submit an application to Edison State Community College.
- 4. This agreement will be valid for a period of three years from the effective date with an annual review by program instructor and college professor. The parties will meet every three years to update curriculum and assessment procedures and to approve a new agreement.
- 5. Changes to this agreement may be requested at any time by notification from either party.
- 6. Credits will be added to the transcript and counted toward a pathway degree program at Edison State Community College.
