Degree Requirements

To qualify for the Bachelor of Science in Psychology, a student must have completed all Ohio University graduation requirements: general education, College, major, and residency. Students must complete a minimum of 30 semester credit hours of Ohio University credit; elective hours may be required; a minimum of 50% of the major course requirements at Ohio University; and total hours for graduation (120 semester hours) with a 2.0 GPA. Students must also complete a minimum of 60 semester hour's equivalent to Ohio University 2000-level or above Arts & Sciences coursework.
