Agreement for the Articulation of Tech Prep Curricula Graphic Communications

Edison State Community College and Tri Star Career Compact

Effective August 2024

Purposes:

- > To recognize the achievement of students and faculty at Tri Star Career Compact (TSCC)
- > To offer college credit to all TSCC students and to award credit for those who merit it
- > To create a seamless pathway to college that avoids unnecessary duplication of content
- > To hold both high school and college students to the same rigorous standards for credit This agreement applies to students who have:
 - 1. Successfully completed the two-year Graphic Communications program at TSCC.
 - 2. Earned an average grade of B or better in program coursework at TSCC.

The parties agree that:

- 1. College credit will be articulated for the appended college courses (Application for College Credit) with a passage rate of 70% or higher on the college administered proficiency exam or other means of assessment required by Edison State Community College.
- 2. The TSCC instructor will submit each student's Application for College Credit to Edison State Community College by the stated deadline.
- 3. All students requesting articulated credit will submit an application to Edison State Community College.
- 4. This agreement will be valid for a period of three years from the effective date with an annual review by the TSCC program instructor and Edison State Community College Program Director. The parties will meet every three years to update curriculum and assessment procedures and to approve a new agreement.
- 5. Changes to this agreement may be requested at any time by notification from either party.
- 6. Credits will be added to the transcript and counted toward a pathway degree program at Edison State Community College.
