- All students with declared Psychology major are automatically admitted as Pre-Psychology students.
- In order to be admitted fully as a psychology major at Wright State, students will need to achieve a cumulative GPA of a 2.0. Additionally, in order to be admitted fully into Behavioral Neuroscience, Clinical Psychology, Cognition and Perception, or Industrial and Organizational Psychology Concentration, students will need to achieve a cumulative GPA of a 3.2.
- Students must earn a C or higher in PSY 121S at Edison State.
- 120-129 hours minimum are required for a BS degree at Wright State.

Clinical Psychology students must choose BIO 121S and 122S for the Ohio Transfer 36 Natural and Physical Sciences requirement at Edison State. General, Cognition/Perception, and Industrial/Organizational students may choose any two Ohio Transfer 36 Natural and Physical Sciences courses. Pre-Health Sciences students must complete BIO 121S, BIO 122S, CHM 121S, and CHM 122S.


