



ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Jay County High School – Agriculture Pathway Programs
Effective August 2026

Purposes:

- To recognize the achievement of students and faculty at Jay County High School
To offer college credit to all affiliated students and to award credit for those who merit it
To create a seamless pathway to college that avoids unnecessary duplication of content
To hold both high school and college students to the same rigorous standards for credit

This agreement applies to students who have:

- 1. Successfully completed the applicable Agriculture career field pathway course(s).

The parties agree that:

- 1. College credit will be articulated for the appended college courses (Application for College Credit) for achievement of the IDOE end-of-course performance standard.
2. The Jay County High School instructor will submit each student’s Application for College Credit to Edison State Community College by the stated deadline.
3. All Jay County High School students requesting articulated credit will submit an application to Edison State Community College.
4. This agreement will be valid for a period of three years from the effective date with an annual review by the Jay County High School instructor/administrator and the Edison State Community College program director. The parties will meet every three years to update curriculum and assessment procedures and to approve a new agreement.
5. Changes to this agreement may be requested at any time by notification from either party.
6. Credits will be added to the transcript and counted toward a pathway degree program at Edison State Community College.
